**IMPORTANT NOTE: Parents are responsible for their child(ren) and their safety during the walk.**



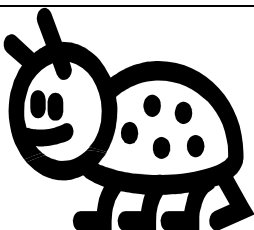
## ***Easter Egg Raffle***

## ***Mufti Day***

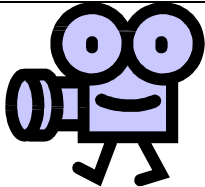
***Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> May***

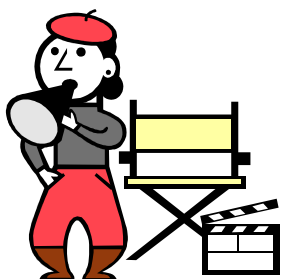

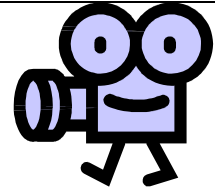
More information will be sent out nearer the date but some items we will be asking for are:

Jars filled with novelty items for our jolly jar stall

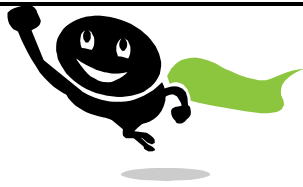
Adult Tombola - Suitable DVD's, wine etc
